

Playground Guidelines

1. The first supervisor out will take the equipment bucket and the walkie-talkie.
2. Adults must be positioned so all areas of the playground can be supervised. (Field, 4 Square, playground, gaga ball pit)
3. Playground equipment is to be used as it was intended. In other words, children slide DOWN the slide, they do not run up or down, the rock wall is to be climbed up only, the horizontal bars are not for perching – they are to be used for arm-over-arm movement, the preschool toys and swings are for preschoolers only, the legs of the swing set are not to be climbed and the tubes & railings of the playground equipment are not meant to be climbing toys.
4. Tag should **not** be played on the playground equipment until there are only one or two grade levels outside (adult decision).
5. No tackling or physical play.
6. Sticks are not to be thrown, used as swords or guns, or brandished about.
7. Monitor the positioning of kickball, football, etc. games.
8. Children are to be visible to playground personnel at all times. No going into pine tree area. Students should not go past midway of the soccer field.
9. No boots, no snow.
10. No throwing snowballs.
11. Sliding on the snow piles will be monitored and when it becomes too icy or dangerous it may be closed to recess use.
12. No jumping off swings.
13. 4-Square will be played by Fr. Andrie's rules at all times.
14. Kind words and actions, fair play and safe choices expected at all times.
